


Important Information!

Broken Starter Housing?

THIS TYPE OF DAMAGE IS NOT COVERED BY YOUR WARRANTY!

Under normal operating conditions, a starter is not capable of developing enough torque to cause this type of damage:



The problem is typically caused by an engine backfire or “kickback”. GM has released Tech Service Bulletins addressing this issue; the cause is usually one of the following:

- **Crank Position Sensors**
- **Fuel Pressure Regulator**
- **Timing Belt**
- **PCM or ECM**
- **Misaligned / improperly mounted starter**
- **Distributor cap**
- **Valve adjustment**
- **Use of starting fluid**

The correct repair to the engine management system should be made prior to replacement of the starter.
